



# Nature of the Course

Students on the pre-registration course are students of Flinders University and will be given access to the University's resources such as the library and publications such as WebCT.

The first year pre-registration course comprises 2 semesters of full-time study – based in Singapore. Students will complete 36 study units during the year: 4 topics of 4.5 units each and 2 topics of 9 units each.

The integrated curriculum supports 10 key elements that are represented throughout the curriculum.
